On the 12th to 14th of April 2013 the fourth addition of Manifest conference took place in Krotoszyn, Poland. Over 120 young people came from all over the country. As usual it turned out to be an incredible time- time of God's work in the lives of many present there. A word from the coordinator, Wioletta Hatak: I have organized manifests for over 9 years and it is true that every time God surprises us with what goes on at those conferences. But the last one was really unusual. What happened at the conference was what I had dreamt of, prayed for, and planned in my head for three years, trying to figure out the scenario for a cross-generational manifest where the words from Malachi could be fulfilled: "His preaching will turn the hearts of fathers to their children and the hearts of children to their fathers." That act of reconciliation happened when one of the fathers present at the manifest on Saturday evening fell on his knees and on behalf of all parents apologized for failing as a good example of faith and holiness to their children. Then also the youth apologized on behalf of all children for those times when they did not respect their parents. There were a lot of tears of joy, forgiveness and reconciliation that evening. This is something only God could do.
