Movement of God's leaders

Calling Discovery workshops

This model that we pioneered last year is now promoted in all GLS campuses throughout the world. We did it again this year and it was a great time of ministry.




In God's Presence

Here is what Methodist pastor and director of Polish edition of GLS - Dr Piotr Gasiowski said about it: "Courageous and pioneering publication where every chapter is worth its own book. It starts debate and deeper reflection concerning evangelical identity and it's culture". Wojtek's chapters are focusing on development of spiritual leadership, missional engagement of evangelicals in contemporary society and social responsibility.

We also got final versions of short movies featuring Right From the Heart clips recorded last summer which will be released in December – we already have over 4500 people receiving daily devotionals and hope that this number will grow because of this movie campaign.





CEL Coaching training for mentors and the conference

This year we started a third edition of CEL and trained all the mentors involved in the programme which pairs experienced leaders with younger generation and recently did second conference for over 50 participants and were really blessed with a positive response

from the leaders representing churches throughout Poland. We led a workshop session called Wheel of Life which allowed the participants to evaluate priorities in every aspect of their lives.
