What a privilege it has been to travel throughout the Czech Republic these last several months meeting with many people who desire to learn how better to grow in Christ. Not only did we seek ways to live Christ-centered lives with them, but we now better understand the pressures and needs these believers are experiencing as well as being able to observe how different churches have responded. Because our focus is on relational needs we were able to identify the areas of struggle marriages and individuals experience. This continuous flow of communication is so precious to us and is helpful as we work to serve others better! During these months we were also privileged to continue our work with individuals and pastors.

SEMINARS

In December Pavel defended his dissertation, Conflict Transformation in Marriage, which has been one of the themes of our seminars. Over the last years we have collected extensive material regarding specific ways in which conflict can bring new life, and deeper

levels, to relationships. Our seminars are designed to deal with different aspects of transformation which can happen during conflicts whether these conflicts be in the church, marriage, relational conflict, or a theology of conflict. God can and does change us through conflict.

Conflict happens often in life and yet we as Christians are often ill-equipped to deal with it. Because God knows our every need, the Bible speaks in depth about not only the reality of conflict but ways to approach them in godly ways.

One of our seminars took place at a church that had just gone through a conflict with their pastor resulting in a lot of hurt and strong emotions. We dealt strictly
